

The Youth International Party (YIP), also known as Yippies, is a loosely knit, antiestablishment revolutionary youth organization formed in New York City in January, 1968. Following a factional dispute in May, 1972, the YIP divided into two factions, the Yippies and the Zippies, headed by THOMAS FORCADE, a member of the underground press syndicate.


JERRY RUBIN and ABBIE HOFFMAN on June 18, 1970, were found guilty of anti-riot law violations that arose from activities during the Democratic National Convention in Chicago, Illinois, in August, 1968. Pending an appeal, they were released on bond by the U.S. Court of Appeals, Chicago, Illinois.

On August 20, 1972, the Students for a Democratic Society (SDS) held a demonstration at the Fontainebleau Hotel, Miami Beach, Florida. ABBIE HOFFMAN was among those present. The crowd was hostile and ABBIE was involved in holding the crowd. Once back at Flamingo Park, the crowd was proud of the way they were able to keep important people out of the hotel.



It is felt the following information qualifies subject for inclusion on the ADEX:

was one of the organizers of the Youth International Party (YIP).

The subject is a convicted Defendant in the socalled Conspiracy Seven Trial, Chicago, Illinois, involving those persons indicted earlier for violation of the Federal Anti-Riot Statute, as a result of protest activities surrounding the August, 1968, Democratic Convention in Chicago, Illinois. On 2/20/70, subject was sentenced to five years imprisonment and fined \$5,000 plus payment of court costs. As a result of the trial, on 2/15/70, he was found guilty of fifteen separate contempt citations and sentenced to a total of 25 months and 23 days imprisonment. On 2/28/70, the US Court of Appeals (USCA), Seventh Circuit, Chicago, Illinois, ordered subject be released on \$25,000 bond. The contempt citations against subject were remanded to the Executive Committee of the US District Court (USDC), Chicago, on 5/11/72, for reassignment to an unbiased Judge, for his subsequent review and a jury trial.

The subject has an extensive arrest record, including arrests for disorderly conduct and resisting arrest.

In an interview on CBS-TV, Chicago, Illinois, on 5/12/68, the subject advised he was in favor of the overthrow of the United States Government by any means possible.





C. Arrests

On May 11, 1972 the United States Court of Appeals, Seventh Circuit, Chicago, in connection with the subject's conviction for Anti-Riot Law (ARL) violations at Chicago, Illinois, in August, 1968, remanded all contempt citations against non-lawyer appelants to the Executive Committee of the United States District Court (USDC), Chicago, for re-assignment to an unbiased Judge for his subsequent review and a jury trial. (unclassified)

As of October 30, 1972, no Judge has been assigned to conduct the rehearing of subject's contempt citations, despite the fact that the chief obstacle to the proceedings, that is the Government's decision as to whether to drop contempt proceedings against Defendant BOBBY SEALE, has been resolved. (unclassified)

No opinion from the Court of Appeals has been forthcoming regarding the substantive ARL convictions, despite the fact that oral agreements in that matter were heard by the Court in February, 1972. (unclassified)





night sleep-in was attempted by the Zippies the night of August 13-14, 1972, at Flamingo Park. He stated that during the evening over half of a crowd of about 50 or 60 departed and at about 3:00 a.m. the remaining persons were told they had 15 minutes to leave the park. They did leave and there were no arrests and no violence occurred.

The Miami Conventions Coalition (MCC) was formed to coordinate activities of groups demonstrating at the Democratic National Convention and Republican National Convention in Miami Beach, Florida, during summer of 1972.

Approximately 50 members of the Zippie faction of the YIP were admitted to the Sub-committee on Human Resources which was meeting at the Fontainebleau Hotel on August 15, 1972, Miami Beach, Florida. At that time a proposal was made by them that the committee "go on record and so instruct the Sergeant of Arms to prevent all murders, war criminals and international outlaws from entering the convention hall and participating in the processes of the convention" and also to do the same with people who violate the Constitution of the United States. There were no incidents during this meeting and no arrests were made.

Special Agent, FBI, Miami, August 15, 1972



On August 15, 1972, demonstrations took place at the Eden Roc and Fontainebleau Hotels, Miami Beach, Florida. At this particular time, the Republican Convention Rules Committee was in session at the Eden Roc. The demonstration consisted of about 25 persons holding placards bearing such slogans as "Make Abortions a Political Issue," "Stop the War Now," "One Point Peace Program-U.S. Out of America Now-Zippies," "War Criminals Out of Miami Beach." The signs indicated the demonstrations were sponsored by the Zippies. There were no incidents and no arrests were made. It was noted that WILLIAM CRAMMER, Chairman, Republican Rules Committee, had informed the demonstrators it was an open meeting and they could come

Special Agents, FBI, Miami, August 15, 1972

On August 16, 1972, a demonstration was held at the Fontainebleau Hotel, Miami Beach, Florida. This demonstration was from 12;30 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. and was sponsored by the YIP. There were about 60 demonstrators and it was noted that several of them were also Zippies. The demonstrators wanted to go into the hotel but were turned back and were told they could not enter. held a demonstration near the entrance to the hotel and on the circular drive leading to the hotel entrance. About five of the Yippies did vomit near some bushes where they were demonstrating and this constituted the planned "puke-in" which they had hoped to have inside the hotel. The demonstrators had numerous signs such as "War Criminals Out of Miami Beach," "Nixon Hates Gays," "Abortion Now," "Nixon is a Pirate," "Free Dope," "Liberate Gay People," "\$6,500 for Four," "Napalm Hurts,"
"Stop bombing the Dikes," "Power to the Viet Cong," and "Kick Nixon Out." They sang some songs such as "1, 2, 3, 4, we don't want your (obsenity) war," and "Power to the People" to a rock music beat.

About 15 managed to slip into the hotel through different entrances but were immediately spotted and ejected. There were no arrests and no violence occurred.



It is noted that about 40 minutes prior to the demonstration, one demonstrator, who was a Yippie, stood outside the hotel dressed in black with white grease paint on his face.

On August 17, 1972, RENNIE DAVIS, JEFF SCHERO, also known as Jeff Nightbyrd, and SHARI WHITEHEAD managed to enter the room where the Platform Committee of the Republican National Convention was holding hearings. The hearings took place at the Fontainebleau Hotel on Collins Avenue, Miami Beach. When the three individuals had proceeded almost to the speaker's platform, they were discovered and members of the committee requested police to evict them from the room. The three individuals were carried out of the room by police officers but were not arrested. After being bodily removed, these three persons spoke at length to newsmen on the street in front of the hotel. This event had occurred at about 11:45 a.m. Just before noon, approximately 15 to 20 individuals, who were reportedly members of the YIP and the Vietnam Veterans Against the War, were assembled in the open area immediately in front of the Fontainebleau Hotel near the point where the three persons who had been evicted from the committee hearing were talking with members of the press.


RENNARD DAVIS, also known as Rennie Davis, was found guilty in the U.S. District Court, Northern District of Illinois, Chicago, Illinois, during February, 1970, on violation of Federal anti-riot laws arising out of his participation in the riots during the Democratic National Convention in Chicago in 1968. DAVIS was sentenced but was released on \$25,000.00 bond by the U.S. Court of Appeals, Chicago.





The Vietnam Veterans Against the War (VVAW) is an anti-war organization organized in 1967 with headquarters in New York City. Its published objective is to "demand an immediate cessation and the withdrawal of American troops in Indo-China." The VVAW has participated in numerous demonstrations including massive demonstrations in Washington, D.C., September 19-23, 1971.

JERRY RUBIN and ABBIE HOFFMAN on June 18, 1970, were found guilty of anti-riot violations which arose from activities during the Democratic National Convention in Chicago, Illinois, in August, 1968. Pending an appeal, they were released on bond by the U.S. Court of Appeals, Chicago, Illinois.

On August 20, 1972, a march and demonstration sponsored by the Zippies took place at Miami Beach, Florida. The march started at about 1:30 p.m. from Flamingo Park and proceeded to the area of the convention hall. Some "Jesus freaks" were among the Zippies; and although the Zippies started this, it appeared demonstrators from various groups had joined in both in the park and during the line In front of the convention headquarters, they a Holy Bible and some symbolic "honkie" culture items and the American flag from the top of a black van truck which was then used by them as a speaker's platform. Speeches were made denouncing the American Government after which they poured what was reportedly urine from the top of the black van on the two objects of "honkie" culture. After this, the crowd was invited by the speakers to come forward and urinate on the flag. About 100 members of the crowd surged forward to take part in this and it could not be determined whether these members did physically urinate on the flag. The demonstrators had a large paper mache marijuana cigarette.

About 250 people participated in this and the demonstration disbanded about 3:30 p.m. This march and demonstration was called Dishonor America Day and Zippies





were also in attendance. There was no violence and no arrests in connection with this particular matter occurred


Special Agent, FBI, Miami August 20, 1972

Students for a Democractic Society (SDS) was founded during June, 1962, at Port Huron, Michigan, and in the 1960s functioned as the leading New Left Campus-based student organization in the United States. From an initial posture of "Participating Democracy" SDS moved to a radical-revolutionary position with debate centering on how best to create a revolutionary youth movement. Internal factionalism produced a split during the SDS national convention in June, 1969, which resulted in the following three factions: Weathermen, Worker Student Alliance (WSA), and Revolutionary Youth Movement (RYM). The Weathermen and RYM are no longer affiliated with the SDS. The WSA continues to use the name SDS, and maintains its national headquarters in Boston, Massachusetts.

On August 21, 1972, a march and demonstration was held at Miami Beach and it had actually been sponsored by approximately 150 Zippies. This began at 3:45 p.m. at Flamingo Park. The demonstrators marched to the convention area where they held a rally to show opposition to all kinds of repression and they specifically noted repression of political prisoners. Two males and four females participated in the demonstration in the rude



The activities ended about 6:00 p.m. after which most of them returned to Flamingo Park. There were no arrests and no violence in connection with this matter.



On the afternoon of August 22, 1972, a group of about three to four hundred persons, mostly Zippies, demonstrated in the area of the convention hall, Miami Beach. Some of these people started burning some flag bunting on a pole and they were surrounded by the Florida Highway Patrol. The Patrol started to make arrests and there was no difficulty in making the arrests. The group demonstrating was described as a "mixed group" in which persons from several different types of groups were represented.



On August 22, 1972, a large demonstration took place in the afternoon which started out as a Zippie demonstration. There were about 400 people and during the march from Flamingo Park to the convention area, a window in a bank was broken. During the demonstration, there was some pounding on cars and some obsenities shouted and finally the Florida Highway Patrol moved in. In connection with this demonstration, although the Zippies are being blamed for this demonstration and numerous others, a good many of the persons involved are not real Zippies but merely "street people" who had drifted into the Miami and Flamingo Park area.





Through review of the files at the Bureau of Tax Records, East Hampton, Long Island, New York, in December, 1972, by a representative of the FBI, it was determined that on August 25, 1972, the premises at 598 Three Mile Harbor Road was sold by Structured for Living Corporation, 251 Guard Drive, East Hampton, Long Island, New York, to one LEAH KUSHNER, 80 Park Avenue, New York, New York. KUSHNER obtained a Bargain and Sale Deed for \$10,000 down payment and she assumed a mortgag of \$23,700.00, which is held by the Southold Savings Bank,



The Certificate was executed by ABRAHAM L. WAY, Attorney at Law, 485 Lexington Avenue, New York, New York, on July 16, 1970.

A review of the Certificate reflects the purpose of the corporation is as follows:

To organize, operate, deal in and with sales promotion agencies, whether independently or for other firms or organizations, and in connection therewith or otherwise conduct each and every activity normally associated with a sales promotion agency or effort: To design, manufacture, buy, sell, deal in and with products, items, notions and/or other matters or things used in connection with sales and/or promotion campaigns or efforts, and otherwise.

**Mk. To organize, operate, deal in and with premium trading stamps, redemption certificates, notions, premium products, sales advertisements, sales devices and any other thing, product, or item used in premiums, promotions, and sales efforts, or otherwise.



- "(3) The corporation, in furtherance of its corporate purposes above set forth, shall have all of the powers enumerated in Section 252 of the Susiness Corporation Law, subject to any limitations provided in the Business Corporation Law or any other statute of the State of New York.
- "(4) The office of the corporation is to be located in the City of New York, County of New York, State of New York.
- "(5) The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation shall have the authority to issue is 200, without par value.
- "(6) The Secretary of State is designated as agent of the corporation upon whom process against it may be served. The post office address to shich the Secretary of State shall mail a copy of any process against the corporation served upon him is:

A Certificate of Amendment was filed on May 31, 1972, changing the name from Youth International Products, to Hopscotch, Incorporated. No other changes were filed. The Amendment was executed by ABBIE HOFFMAN, President, and CAROLE RAMER. Secretary, and was filed by GERALD B. LEFCOURT, Attorney at Law, 640 Broadway, New York, New York.

GERALD LEFCOUT is publicly known as chief legal counsel for the 13 members of the BPP who were on trial during 1970 in NYC Criminal Court on charges of conspiracy to commit arson and murder.

United States Court of Appeals (USCA), Seventh Circuit, Chicago, Illinois, made available a copy of a 121 page opinion of the USCA issued the previous day, which in summary, reversed the substantive Anti-Riot Law convictions of five defendants, including subject, in the trial in United States District Court (USDC), Chicago, Illinois, from September 24, 1969 - February 18, 1970, commonly referred to as the Conspiracy Seven Trial. The USCA remanded the convictions to USDC, Chicago, for a new trial if the Government so desired. As grounds for reversal, the court cited the failure of the presiding trial judge to inquire into the possible effect of pre-trial publicity upon prospective jurors, out of court communications between the trial judge and the jury during its deliberation, and the demeanor of the trial judge and prosecutor, described by the USCA as deprecatory and antagonistic toward defense counsel and defendants during the trial.

The "Chicago Sun-Times," a daily Chicago newspaper, edition of January 5, 1973, Page 4, carried an article entitled, "Justice Department Drops Chicago Seven Riot Case." The article reflected that Attorney General RICHARD KLEINDIENST had announced at a January 4, 1973 press conference in Washington, D.C., that the Justice Department would not retry the five convicted defendants in the Conspiracy Seven Anti-Riot Law case in Chicago. The Government would, however, proceed with



the prosecution of these five individuals (and their associates in the Conspiracy Seven trial) on the contempt of court charges stemming from that trial.

On January 19, 1973, Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) STARKMAN advised that on January 18, 1973, a motion had been filed in USDC, Chicago, before Chief Judge ROBSON, by the United States Attorney's Office, Chicago, to dismiss the Anti-Riot Law charges still pending against the five convicted defendants, including subject. No counsel had appeared representing the defendants, and the motion, uncontested, was granted by Judge ROBSON on January 18, 1973.

STARKMAN also advised that a date of March 5, 1973 has most recently been set for a hearing in USDC, Chicago, for oral arguments on all motions filed by the Government and defense counsel in the contempt proceedings still pending regarding the five defendants, and four others, resulting from the Conspiracy Seven trial. No trial date has as yet been set for these contempt proceedings. Pending outcome of the contempt retrial, the subject remains free on bond.

during the YIP National Congress in Columbus, the subject and JERRY RUBIN, who are regarded as the original founders of YIP, were criticized for stealing YIP funds, for having allied themselves with the Democratic Party, and for working through the system of the "establishment." As a result, it was decided a press conference would be held to announce the expulsion of RUBIN/and HOFFMAN from YIP.

JERRY RUBIN, along with the subject, on February 18, 1970, were found guilty of Anti-Riot Law violations that arose from activities during the National Democratic Convention in Chicago, Illinois, in August, 1968. On November 27, 1972, the United States Court of Appeals, Seventh Circuit, Chicago, reversed the conviction. To date, no decision has been reached regarding contempt citations against RUBIN and subject.

The November 28, 1972 issue of the "New York Times," a daily newspaper in NYC, on Page 30, contained an article statist the YIP Conclave in Columbus, Ohio, had voted to exclude RUBIN and the subject as official spokesmen for the Yippie movement. Both RUBIN and the subject were accused by YIP of using the party for personal gain.

In an article appearing on Page 23 of the "New York Post," a daily newspaper in NYC, issue dated November 27, 1972, the subject denied being a current leader of YIP. Regarding the YIP Conclave in Columbus, Ohio, the subject was quoted as saying, "As far as I'm concerned, it's all pretty boring."





V. WRITINGS

The book, Vote, written by the subject in conjunction with JERRY RUBIN and ED SANDERS, has been made available to the public by Warner Paperback Library, a division of Warner Books, Incorporated, 315 Park Avenue South, New York, first printing October, 1972.

ED SANDERS, author of The Family, a book which pertains to convicted murdered CHARLES MANSON, has in the past been associated with YIP, and is a personal acquaintance of ABBLE HOFFMAN and JERRY RUBIN.

The following quotation is from the cover pages to the book:

"Fifty percent of the advance payment for this book was used by the Youth International Party (YIPPIE) for the purpose of carrying out demonstrations and political activities in Miami Beach. In addition, twenty-five percent went for such expenses as agent fees, travel, and photos. The remaining twenty-five percent was divided among the authors. Of any future royalties, fifty percent will go to Youth International Party, Inc."

Review of the book reflects that it is concerned with activities and personal observations of the authors during the 1972 Democratic Convention in Miami Beach, Florida. Much of



the book is devoted to comparison of President NIXON to Democratic candidate GEORGE MC GOVERN, and to the `changes between the 1968 Democratic Convention and the 1972 Democratic Convention. The subject encouraged exeryone to vote in the 1972 Presidential election.

In a chapter written by JERRY RUBIN and the subject, entitled, "We now work from within to change the System," the authors state that as long as the "system" is flexible, leftists should try to use the system, rather than resort to violence, to achieve the goals of "socialism and peace."





During the Congress, DANA BEAL, a current national YIP leader, accused HOFFMAN of stealing YIP funds, for having allied himself with the Democratic Party, and for working through the system of the "establishment". As a result, HOFFMAN and JERRY RUBIN, who had been regarded as the original founders of YIP, were publicly expelled from YIP at a press conference. In an article appearing on page 23 of the New York Post, a daily newspaper in NYC, issue dated 11/27/72, the subject denied being a leader of YIP. Regarding the YIP Conclave in Columbus, Ohio, the subject was quoted as saying "As far in Columbus, Ohio, the subject the concerned, it's all party boring.



The subject has had no reported subversive activity since the RNC in Miami, 8/21 - 24/72. The subject was not present during YIP protest activities at the 1973 Presidential Inauguration, Washington, D.C., 1/20/73. During a national meetin of YIP at the Inauguration, most Yippies expressed satisfaction that PURIN and subject had been successfully expelled from YIP.

The subject has no reported public appearances since his appearance at an "under attack" program at Rosary Hill College, Snyder, NY, 11/9 - 10/72. The subject was not well accepted and did not have much to say except that he is "tired" of the movement.

In his latest book "Vote", first printing October, 1972, written in conjunction with JERRY RUBIN and ED SANDERS, the subject encouraged everyone to vote in the 1972 Presidential election. In a chapter written in conjunction with JERRY RUBIN, the subject stated that as long as the "system" is flexible leftists should try to use the system, rather than resort to violence, to achieve the goals of "socialism and peace". The chapter was entitled, "We now work from with in to change the system".



Within the past year, the subject has relinquished his claim to a leadership role in the YIP, and no longer serves any revolutionary group in a leadership capacity. The subject has publicly withdrawn from the revolutionary movement





through his own voluntary statements, and has publicly stated through his book that he believes in working through the "system", rather than resorting to violence, to achieve the goals of "socialism and peace".

In view of the above, it is believed the subject no longer qualifies as an "Extremist" or a "Key Activist", and it is recommended the Bureau consider that the subject no longer carried as an "Extremist", and that he be removed as a "Key Activist".

Per re NY FD 122, it was recommended the subject be continued on the ADEX because his past activities portray him as an individual who could constitute a threat to the national defense of the nation in time of a national emergency. As a result, no recommendation is being submitted at this time suggesting subject be removed from ADEX.

Reurlet dated 5/29/73 calling attention to subject's public expulsion from the Youth International Party (YIP) in Movember, 1972, the fact that he has not engaged in any subversive activities since August, 1972, and noting his recommendation that as long as the "system" is flexible, leftists should try to use the system rather than resort to violence to achieve the goals of socialism and peace. Your letter recommended that in view of the foregoing subject no longer be designated a Key Activist or investigated as an extremist.

A review of subject's file at Headquarters indicates that in addition to being a co-founder of the YIP, subject also has an history of New Left violence and an extensive arrest record. In 1972, he authored "Steal This Book," a revolutionary manual complete with instructions concerning the manufacture and use of explosive devices. His speeches include such comments as "these are violent means but I am determined to overthrow the Government" (3/71, London, England); "We're into stopping the Government unless they want to stop the war-they have about 47 hours." (4/29/71); and "The only dope worth shooting is Richard Nixon" (4/28/71).

In connection with the foregoing, while there is little doubt subject no longer maintains his high revolutionary profile and the strong radical following he once commanded, his past actions, speeches and writings clearly demonstrate his willingness and capability to engage in acts dangerous to the internal security of the United States. In view of the foregoing, Hoffman is no longer being considered a Key Activist, however, investigation concerning his activities should continue to be conducted in accordance with existing instructions regarding investigations of extremists.
