PS 335 Transfering the Calibration Coefficients in to the Firmware

1. Locate the sticker on the optics module (see picture) and write down the calibration coefficients.



- 2. Open Diagnostics and go to the *Calibration* tab (1) (see screen capture below).
- 3. You can display the current calibration settings by selecting the *Get Calibration Data* (2) option. Once they are displayed you will need to select the *Write* (3) option and then type in the wavelength coefficients (on the sticker on the top of the new optics module) into the shown calibration file.
- 4. Once this is completed, you will need to save (4) the new coefficients, and then you can then do a lamp cal in either Star or Galaxie software.
