

Remote Connection to the PC

1. You will need to allow your PC to accept remote connections. Go into the *Control Panel* and click on the *System* (1) option.



2. Then select the *Remote* (2) tab and once you open it you need to select both the *Remote Assistance* and the *Remote Desktop* (3) options.



- 3. Click the *Ok* (4) and then the *Apply* (5) buttons to enable this change.
- 4. To connect remotely select the Start/Programs/Accessories/Communication/Remote Desktop Connection.



- 5. If you are connecting to a computer not on the internal network, you will need to type in the IP address of the computer (6) you want and select *Connect* (7).
- 6. If you are connecting to a computer on the internal network, you do not need to know the IP address. You will need to type in the computer's name (6) and then select the *Connect* (7) button.
- 7. The following screen will appear where you will need to enter the login (8) and password for the computer you are connecting to. Once entered click the OK (9) button..



8. You are now connected to the remote desktop selected.
