



ANAREN ANNOUNCES EXECUTION OF LETTER OF INTENT

Syracuse, NY – Anaren, Inc. (NASDAQ: ANEN) today announced that it has signed a non-binding Letter of Intent to acquire M.S. Kennedy Corp. ("MSK"), a Syracuse based manufacturer of analog and mixed signal hybrids used in various military and aerospace applications. MSK had net sales of approximately \$22.4 million in 2007. Pending the successful negotiation of a definitive purchase and sale agreement, the Company anticipates completing the transaction prior to the close of its fiscal year, June 30, 2008.
