



ANAREN RECEIVES \$5.8 MILLION CONTRACT FOR RADAR WARNING RECEIVER SUBASSEMBLY

Syracuse, NY, August 6, 2007 – Anaren, Inc. (NASDAQ: ANEN) has received a \$5.8 million contract from Lockheed Martin [NYSE: LMT] for electronic subassemblies that will help U.S. Navy helicopters detect and identify enemy radar.

Designed to process radar signals detected by a receiver, Anaren's Passive Ranging Subsystem is a major component of Lockheed Martin's AN/ALQ-210 Electronic Support Measures (ESM) system, a sophisticated device carried aboard military helicopters and fixed wing aircraft to warn of possible threats. Lockheed Martin manufactures the ESM system at its Systems Integration facility in Owego, NY.

Lockheed Martin will integrate the finished ESM systems containing Anaren's Passive Ranging Subsystem aboard the U.S. Navy's next-generation MH-60R submarine hunting and surface warfare helicopter. Currently in production, the MH-60R helicopter is built by Sikorsky Aircraft Company and integrated with mission systems by Lockheed Martin.

The order comes just two months after Anaren received an \$8 million order for the same subsystem element from Lockheed Martin intended for Canada's new CH-148 Cyclone Maritime Helicopter. Anaren designs, develops, manufactures and sells highly integrated microwave components, assemblies and subsystems for the wireless communications, satellite communications and defense electronics markets.
