Syracuse, NY | May 21, 2016 – With the recent implementation of the FDA's Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA), food industry professionals have the added task to integrate emerging FSMA data logging modernization standards for temperature monitored refrigerators, coolers, freezers, and other temperature sensitive environments along the food and cold chain.
