John C. McNellis is corporate senior vice president and president of L-3 Aerospace Systems which has more than 20,000 employees worldwide and \$4.5 billion in annual sales. He has held his current position since March 2014.

Mr. McNellis possesses over 30 years of executive and project management experience in a broad spectrum of domestic and international defense programs. He joined L-3 in 2003 as president of Link Simulation and Training with responsibility for managing and growing Link's worldwide operations, and was appointed president of L-3 Integrated Systems Group in November 2008. Prior to L-3, he served as president of Lockheed Martin's Tactical Systems unit and held executive positions at Loral and IBM. Mr. McNellis has an extensive background in aircraft special mission systems, modification and maintenance; C<sup>3</sup>ISR; training systems; and satellite command and control.

Mr. McNellis holds Master of Science and Bachelor of Science degrees in Physics from the University of California at Los Angeles and Santa Clara University, respectively. He also holds a Master of Business Administration from Santa Clara University.
