Steve M. Post General Counsel & Vice President of Contracts L-3 Communications Integrated Systems



Steve M. Post is general counsel and vice president of Contracts for L-3 Communications Integrated Systems (L-3/IS). In this position, Post has responsibility for all legal and contractual matters within L-3/IS. He was appointed to the position in March 2002.

Previously, Post was the vice president of Legal for the business unit, which was acquired by L-3 Communications in the first quarter of 2002.

Post has more than 25 years of diverse legal experience. Previously, he served first as an associate counsel and then as group counsel for the company from 1987 to 1995. He served as assistant general counsel until 1998 and then as a senior counsel until March 2000.

Prior to joining the company, Post was an instructor in the Contract Law department at the Judge Advocate General's School in Charlottesville, Va.

Post received his undergraduate degree from the University of Dayton in 1974 and his Juris Doctor from Indiana University in 1977 from which he graduated Cum Laude. He is also a graduate of the Army's Judge Advocate Officer Basic Course and was an honor graduate in 1977 and graduate course where he was on the Commandant's List in 1984.

Post began his legal and military career at the Office of the Staff Judge Advocate, Ft. Dix, N.J. where he served as the contract and fiscal law advisor and as senior trial counsel. Following that assignment, Post served as a trial attorney in the Litigation Division, Office of the Judge Advocate General at the Pentagon, Washington, D.C. In addition to other publications, Post authored "Recent Developments in Contract Law-1986 in Review," which is an annual article that appears in *The Army Lawyer*.

Post has been married to his wife, Ursula, since 1973 and they have two children — Rebecca and Kevin.

Post is currently the immediate past president of the Board of Trustees for Special Care and Career Services, a non-profit agency, which provides early childhood intervention services and supported employment services in the Dallas area.
