Whitis was appointed to her current position in June 2001.

Whitis joined the company in 1989 as a senior business systems analyst responsible for all phases of the U.S. Customs contract. Since then, she has accepted positions and managed tasks of increased technical and managerial complexity. Whitis has over 22 years of experience in planning, analysis and development of computer-based information systems. In addition she has over 15 years of experience in managing efforts that span the entire systems/software development cycle and 10 years of successful experience in managing Information Technology (IT) contracts for government agencies.
